CDCC Junior Tour Accommodation Guide.

The 2013 Santos / CDCC Junior Tour is coordinated from Wilton Hall, Flaxmans Valley Road, Flaxmans Valley. This is where participants will start and finish from, for the various events over the two days. The event comprises of two road races on the Saturday and a road race on the Sunday followed by an individual time trial. *Distances and race routes depend on on Junior classification.*

There are three major towns in close proximity to the race event.

- Angaston – approx. 6km from Wilton Hall
- Tanunda – approx. 9km from Wilton Hall
- Nuriootpa – approx. 11km from Wilton Hall

These distances are by the way the crow flies, road distances will vary. Adelaide is approx. 60km from Wilton Hall.

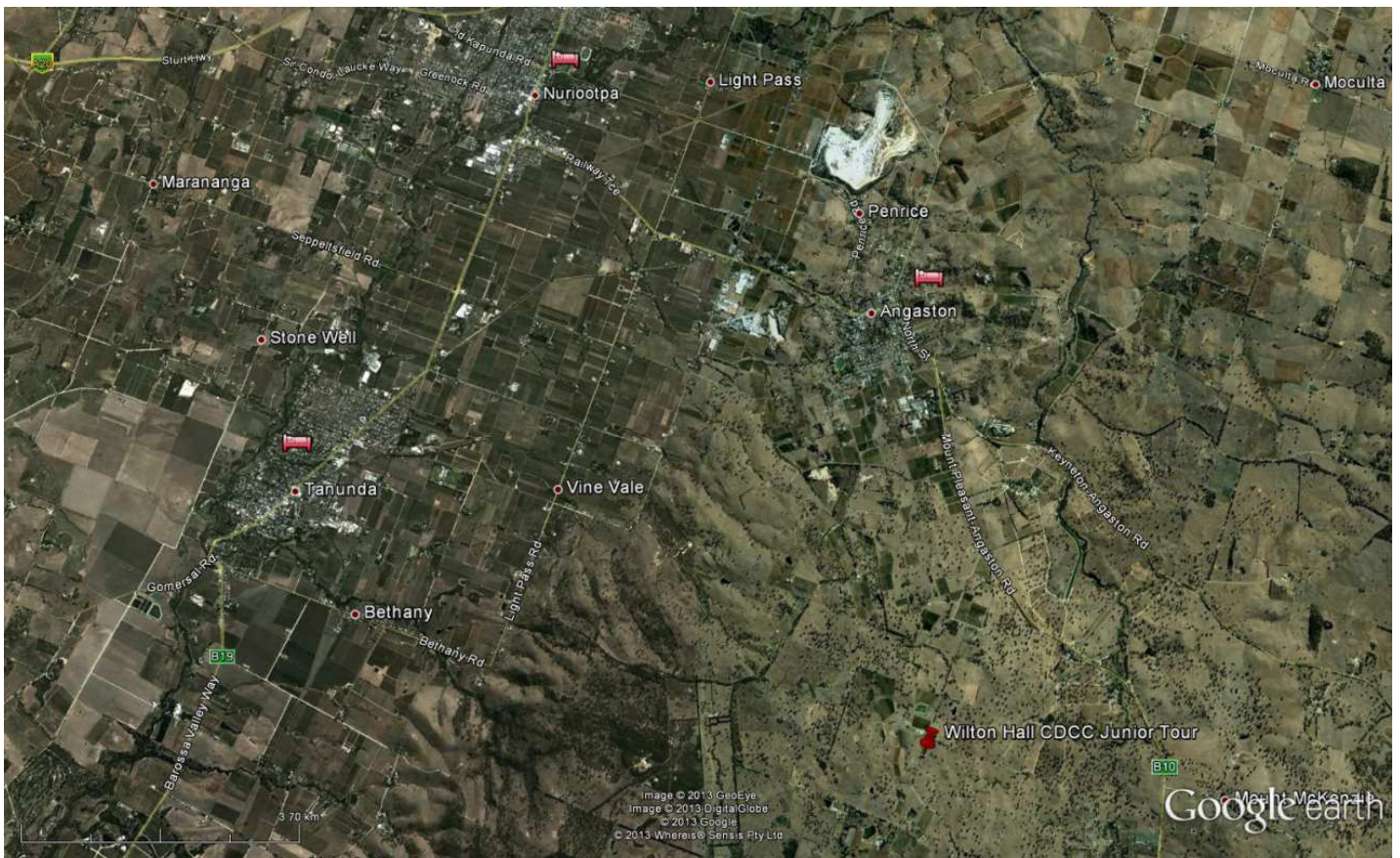
