World Bicycle Relief is a non-profit organization mobilizing people through the Power of Bicycles. World Bicycle Relief is currently working to provide 50,000 bicycles to students (70% girls), teachers and educational workers in rural Zambia and Zimbabwe. Having travelled to rural Zambia last year, Tessa knows the difference that a bicycle would make to the life of someone there.

To most of us, a bicycle is used for recreation, or sport, or transport, and we joke that the correct number of bikes to own is $n+1$, but to people in Africa, especially rural Africa, a bicycle is much more - *it's an engine for economic and cultural empowerment*. Compared to walking, bicycles represent an enormous leap in productivity and access to healthcare, education and economic opportunities. The simple, sustainable nature of bicycles empowers individuals, their families and their communities.

This summer, Tessa & I hope to raise \$1500 at E-town & CX events for World Bicycle Relief, which equates to providing 10 bicycles. 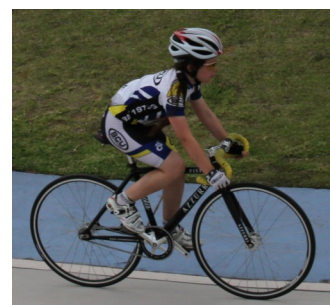
