WHAT Adult size mountain bikes (23 inch wheels/ 15 inch frames and larger) and hybrid bikes are best for the African terrain and long distance travel needs of people in remote communities.

WHY Your old bike will give a student, farmer, health care worker or one of many other disadvantaged people in Namibia faster and easier access to health care, fresh water, education and employment.



Bicycles for Humanity (B4H) is an organisation that collects donated bikes and sends them in a shipping container to Namibia, where they are distributed to those in need by the Bicycle Empowerment Network. They are holding a donation day on Sunday, November 30, 10 am - 12 noon, at Feathers Hotel car park, John St (off Glynburn Rd), Burnside.

Here is an extract from their website:

Please note we can only send Mountain Bikes and Sturdy hybrids in working or easily fixable conditions to developing regions. Please nothing too far gone or rusty.

If your bike is not appropriate for developing regions we may use it in other ways to benefit the project or pass it on to local bike initiatives.

Racers and Cruisers

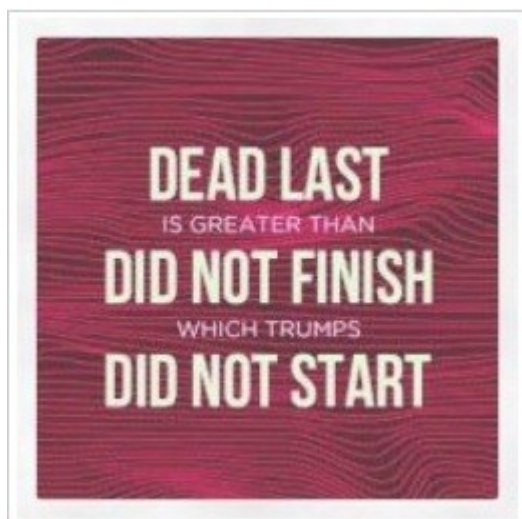
Any retro racers or cruisers in reasonable condition can also be repurposed and benefit the project but cannot be sent to the developing world due to issues with the terrain and replaceable parts.

Kids Bikes

As much as possible we try to limit the bikes sent to adult bicycles. If you do donate a small child's bike it will most likely be passed onto a local refugee program or similar initiative. In the interest of efficiency it is best to donate these directly to these organisations.

B4H will be available to accept your donation of roadworthy adult mountain and hybrid bikes, spare parts and bike tools.

Editor's note: the organisation on the ground in Namibia is similar to World Bicycle Relief, the organisation that Tessa is raising funds for.
