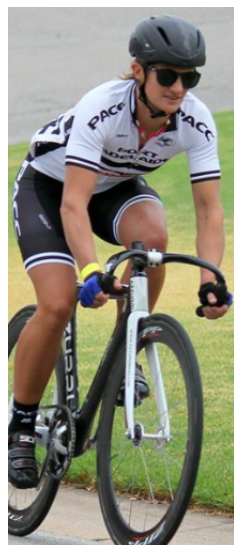

Up to and including Adelaide Cup Day Interclub...here are some useless stats...

Of 69 Senior Riders ...1 rider has attended all 20/20 events & between 69 riders there has been 416 sign-ons

- If we say 416 @ 15kms = 6240kms travelled at race speed through the season.

Of 44 Junior Riders ...1 rider has attended 18/20 events & between 44 riders there has been 231 sign-ons

- If we say 231 @ 10kms = 2310kms travelled at race speed through the season.

Of 14 Little Trakeez ... 1 rider has attended all 20/20 events & between 14 riders there has been 102 sign-ons

- If we say 102 @ 3kms = 306kms travelled at race speed through the season.

So between us we have ridden 8856kms...to drive highway 1 around Australia its about 15000kms.

We are only half way round Australia & we have only 3 nights racing left – we all better get there early next week & put in some kms !!!
