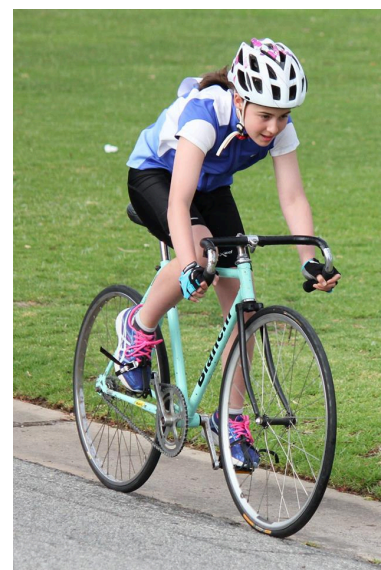
Latest news is that MGCC are putting on an event on the day after Australia Day in the morning so we've got ourselves 2 days of racing.

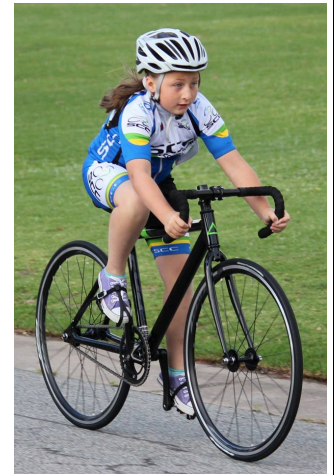

S.A. riders and their *soigneurs* will be part of up to 200 U15 and U17 riders from around the country racing in a dozen events a day in Australia's newest velodrome – which happens to be the venue of the 2018 Commonwealth Games track competition in April.
