

Cycling South Australia Super Series results for South Coast – December 2017

CSA's Super Series has finished on a high with exciting racing and strong competition a feature of the events.

The final Round (or 10 rounds) was held at St Claire criterium circuit on Sunday 10th December and South Coast riders featured well.

The highlight was the hotly-contested Category 2 Women event with Chelsea Holmes finishing in first place, and Staci McCudden finishing strongly in third in a 12-way sprint finish. Both were riding for the CSA Development team along with Series leader Hannah Seeliger of Kilkenny CC. Staci also pick up a lump of points in the Preme sprints.

Bryan McIntyre shone the SCC beacon in the Category 2 Masters race earning a creditable fourth in a 6-way sprint finish and a showing in the presentations.

In the Category 1 Women U19 rider Tessa Kohn had a strong showing amongst SA's elite riders coming in a solid 9th in a small bunch not far behind the fast first finishers.

Jarrod Currie was our other representative in this Round of the Series battling it out in the Category 1 Masters race. He crossed the line 9th in a 14-way sprint finish.

In terms of Series results all our riders can hold their heads high.

- -Bryan finished 7th out of 30 in Category 2 Masters – not bad for an individual entry against some well-support teams! He came out 2nd in the over-50 sub-category.
- Staci celebrated a well-earned 5th place (out of 45 Category 2 Women) – only a few points behind Bronwyn Dolman who set a new Australian record at the National Para Track Championships in Sydney this weekend. Cat 1 next year perhaps?!!
- Chelsea is showing how much she likes this sport of cycling who as a SASI Talent ID find (like Staci and Tessa) has finished 7th (out of 45) – having started the series about half-way through!
- (NB the CSA Development team won the Category 2 Women's Series finishing quite a few points ahead of one of the professional Blackchrome Butterfields team!)
- Tessa only contested about half of the Rounds of this series but still finished 16th out of 31 in the Category 1/Elite Women. She rode for the Butterfields Focus Team.
- Jarrod has come back very well over the past year or so and has finished a very creditable 4th out of 34 riders in the Category 1 Masters series from only about 2/3 of the Rounds. He rode for the BE-BMW team and has ended up their highest-placed rider. He also took out 2nd in the Sprint classification.
