



Official opening of Edwardstown Soldiers' Memorial Recreation Ground – your invitation

You are invited to attend the official opening of the \$8.8 million redevelopment of Edwardstown Soldiers' Memorial Recreation Ground on Saturday, 13 April.

Nicolle Flint MP and I will open the new complex at 12 noon. The old building has been transformed into a modern sporting and community complex, which features:

- Two-storey clubroom with commercial kitchen
- Four function rooms
- Change rooms
- Resurfaced velodrome
- Spectator viewing mound
- Cricket nets
- Additional car parking
- Storage facilities
- New memorial gardens, including pavers that acknowledge past conflicts.

The Edwardstown World War One honour board has also been installed in the clubrooms. Activities will run from 11am to 2pm and include guided tours, come and try sports, a free sausage sizzle, and a performance by Marion City Band.

Marion Council provided \$4.8 million of funding and the Australian Government \$4 million. Upgrades to the memorial garden have been supported by \$18,500 grant from Veterans SA and an Armistice Centenary Grant of \$21,137 from the Department of Veterans Affairs.
